IN 2025, WE BEGAN TRAINING YOUTH LEADERS FROM THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, TOGETHER WITH HANSEL CASTILLO, LEADER OF "NEXTMOVE" FOR LATIN AMERICA.

THE RESULTS OF THIS COLLABORATION ARE SHOWING FRUITS OF SERVICE AMONG YOUNG LEADERS, SHARING RESOURCES, AND THANKS TO THAT, MORE YOUNG PEOPLE ARE COMING TO KNOW JESUS.











In March, we trained local teams in Puerto Rico as part of a collaborative effort with **NaLEC**. We managed to gather leaders from the Puerto Rican government and other sectors to seek solutions to the socio-spiritual problems on the island together. It was an exceptional time.











In April, we developed two trainings in Panama City. The first with the Global Table team and the second with local leaders from **Panama City**. **Hermes Espino**, a leader with decades of experience in Panama, said, "I had never been in such an excellent training on how to transform a city." They are coming together to improve three cities: **Panama City**, **Veracruz**, and Colón City.

On another note, it was gratifying to advocate for Latinos in the U.S. Congress by sharing with my new friend and brother in Christ, **Bill Huizenga, the Congressman from Michigan**.

God is doing great things; we just need to take action and believe.





LEADERS TRAINING



Since our meeting on May 2, we have been very active, offering **trainings both online and in-person.**









In August, we held an event in **Guatemala City**, and we are currently focused on various training meetings in the United States.



We started this project with 50 leaders from 10 countries and 16 different cities. It has been a truly extraordinary experience. The lessons they are learning revolve around how to transform their cities, attract new people to Jesus Christ, and advance the Kingdom of God.



HERE ARE THE MAIN CLASSES BEING DEVELOPED:

- 2. CROWN AND FRUIT THE PURPOSE, THE GOALS TO TRANSFORM A CITY.

- 4. SEED WHAT IS NEEDED TO BUILD A CITY NETWORK?
- 5. SOIL THE ECOSYSTEM AND CONTEXT OF A CITY NETWORK.
- 6. TRUNK THE CULTURE AND INTERNAL STRUCTURE OF A CITY NETWORK.
- 7. FORK EXTERNAL MODEL AND ARCHITECTURE OF A CITY NETWORK.
- 8. LIMBS DEVELOPMENT OF CITY NETWORKS.
- 9. BRANCHES EFFECTIVE INTERACTION NETWORKS.
- 10. NUTRIENTS HOW TO BE MULTIPLIERS LEADING A CITY NETWORK?
- 11. TOOLS KNOWING THE TECHNOLOGICAL, PHYSICAL, AND OTHER TOOLS OF OUR CITIES.
- 12 CLIMATE AND WEATHER THE EXTERNAL ISSUES OF THE CITY AND HOW TO FACE THEM.











DURING JULY 29 AND 30, WE TRAINED OVER 30 REGIONAL LEADERS, INCLUDING REPRESENTATIVES FROM GUATEMALA, PANAMA, BRAZIL, CHILE, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, COSTA RICA, ARGENTINA, AND THE UNITED STATES.



We reviewed each class, going over the lessons already taught and moving on to the next. It was a time of fellowship, planning, and growth.









WE EXPECTED THE PARTICIPATION OF 200 KEY LEADERS, BUT WE WERE SURPRISED BY THE ATTENDANCE OF 289 PEOPLE. WE HAD TO ADD CHAIRS AND TABLES IN THE EARLY MORNING TO ACCOMMODATE EVERYONE.









The teachings focused on building trust, collaborative work, and forming networks in different urban sectors. We had the presence of Rob Kelly, Eddie Copeland, and other local leaders like Alex Gudiel.









It was inspiring to feel the synergy as participants planned together how to serve in their countries.
